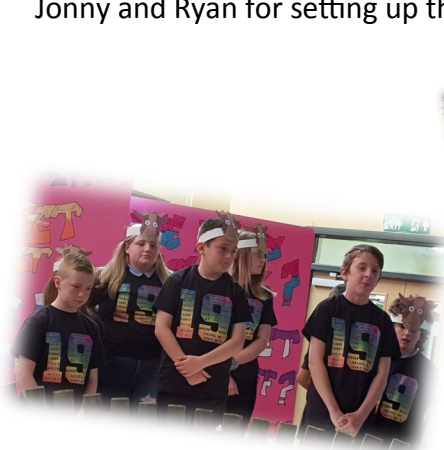


# Summer Newsletter 2019
